TOYO-INDIA – CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY (CSR) ACTIVITIES DURING 2018-19

During the last few years, as a responsible corporate citizen, Toyo-India, through its various Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiatives has been doing its contribution in helping the marginalized and underprivileged sections of the society. We continue to focus on education, healthcare, sanitation, water conservation, making available safe drinking water etc., as our commitment to the sustainable model of development.

During the year 2018-19 also the Company made contribution towards various CSR activities as under:

At the beginning of the academic year, in July 2018, the Company distributed 2 uniform sets for 642 boys and girl students of a school in backward area. The students who mainly come from underprivileged sections of the society were very happy as they could get new uniforms at the beginning of the academic year.





Contribution was also made for infrastructure development activities in two schools in Kota District, Rajasthan. These schools are located near our Chambal Fertilisers project site.



For making available safe drinking water, contribution was made to install drinking water pipeline in a village in Rajasthan.

With our CSR contribution, artificial limbs were provided to about 25 physically disabled persons.

We also funded the construction of 3 Classrooms in a school in backward area. The earlier classrooms were very old and in a dilapidated condition.





Under the Happy Schools Project, Toyo-India also contributed for modernisation of 10 Government Primary and Junior High Schools in Gorakhpur near the HURL Project site by providing necessary infrastructure.





Toyo-India also made contribution to a school in Gujarat for meeting the day to day and administrative expenses. This is a residential School where students and teachers both stay at the school premises. The school offers learning in Sanskrit and Vedas and promotes multi-dimensional development of students.
